This term we are going to be covering the following topic:	
<b>Maths</b>	The children will build on previous experiences of number from their home and nursery environments, and further develop their subitising and counting skills.
<b>English</b>	<u>The Something</u> : Reception will be introduced to story friends who help them retell stories in their own words. The children will be introduced to new vocabulary and verbally forming sentences.
<b>Phonics</b>	The children will be introduced to their Set 1 sounds, beginning with learning the picture prompts and then learn the sound that accompanies them. The children will also begin to form their set 1 sounds by writing with pencils into exercise books.
<b>Understanding the World</b>	<u>Celebrate Me and My Environment</u> : Reception will be beginning to think about themselves, recognising their body parts and using their senses. They will then be thinking about our local environment, understanding where we live and what the environment is like around us. The children will also be spending lots of time in their outdoor area to make sense of the natural world.
<b>RE</b>	<u>Creation and Covenant</u> : pupils will encounter the God who creates and calls a people. They will be introduced to different Bible scripture and stories to help them understand the story of creation. They will engage in different activities throughout provision to show their understanding.
<b>Collective Worship</b>	<u>Generosity</u> : Reception will be introduced to the word generosity and think of different examples of being generous. They will listen to different scriptures and engage in different activities to help them understand further.

<b>Art</b>	<u>Frida Kahlo (Drawing)</u> : The children will be learning about the artist Frida Kahlo. They will be practicing their drawing skills and build up to drawing a self portrait.
<b>PSHE</b>	<u>Being Me in My World</u> : Reception will be thinking about the feelings of themselves and others around them. We will be creating classroom rules and understanding how to be a good friend.
