This term we are going to be covering the following topic:				
Maths	<u>Place value</u> - Children will explore numbers to 100, looking at tens and ones.			
	Children will also continue counting in 2s, 5s, and 10s and will be learning to count			
	in 3s.			
Phonics	Children will continue in their Read Write Inc. phonics groups, learning sounds,			
	practising spelling and reading story books.			
English	<u>Circular narrative</u> - Children will explore their new class text, A River. Children will			
	begin to use question marks, full stops and exclamation marks, they will be looking			
	at apostrophes for possession and expanded noun phrases.			
Science	<u>Living Things: Our Local Environment</u> - Children will explore different animals and			
	their habitats, both local and in the wider world, as well as dependency and survival.			
Geography	Seasons – Children will be learning about the different seasons, months and			
	weather using observational skills.			
RE	<u>Creation and Covenant</u> – Children will explore the story of Noah's Ark and baptism.			
Collective Worship	Generosity – Children will explore stories of generosity and how we can live this.			
Art	Sculpture: Clay Houses – Children will explore the use of clay as a medium and plan			
	and create a clay house tile.			
Computing	<u>Importance of Computers</u> – Children will identify all the uses of different types of			
	computers in everyday life.			
PE	Games – Children will engage in competitive and co-operative physical activities.			

PSHE	Being Me in My World – Children will explore how to be part of a responsible classroom community. They will consider their rights, rewards and consequences in order to create a learning charter.
Music	Children will be learning news songs and looking at finding the pulse and rhythm in music.
