This term we are going to be covering the following topic:				
Maths	Place value - Children will explore numbers up to 1,000 using concrete,			
	pictorial and abstract questions. They will use concrete resources such as			
	counters, Dienes, Base 10s, number lines and place value charts to support their			
	learning.			
	Addition and subtraction - Children will begin to explore adding and			
	subtracting 3-digit numbers.			

Approaching Threat Narrative and Trap Explanation - Children will explore		
the book 'The Iron Man'. They will use this text to complete two different		
writing outcomes - Approaching Threat Narrative and Trap Explanation.		
Plants - Children will explore the different parts of a plant, how they grow and		
the different stages in the life cycle of a plant.		
Ancient Egypt - Children will discover the history of Ancient Egypt. They will		
learn about how they lived and how this changed over time.		
Homes, - Children will explore how they can show a loving heart at home.		
Generosity - Children will learn about the importance of sharing with others.		
Prehistoric Painting - Children will explore prehistoric paintings and how long		
ago it was produced. They will use charcoal to recreate their own cave		
paintings and apply their knowledge of mixing colour to make natural colours		
<u>Introduction to Scratch - Children will explore 'Scratch' to complete coding</u>		
and programming activities. They will to program sprites using a range of		
blocks to add animation, sound and other effects		
<u>Dance - Children will develop their coordination, flexibility, strength and special</u>		
awareness while learning to work together positively.		
Being Me in my World - Children will set their own personal goals for Year 3		
and how they can face new challenges positively. They will learn how to be		
responsible and understand that how their actions can affect others.
