This term we are going to be covering the following topic:	
Maths	<p><u>Place value</u> - Children will explore the ins and outs of place value and place value charts, including numbers that go up to 10 million. Children will also look at powers up to 10, rounding numbers and negative numbers.</p> <p><u>Addition, subtraction, multiplication and division</u> – This unit will look at all the basics of the four operations, as well as long multiplication, long and short division and remainders.</p> <p><u>Fractions A&B</u> – Here we will look at equivalent fractions, adding and subtracting, comparing and ordering and looking at how to do all of these with both mixed numbers, proper and improper and equivalent fractions.</p> <p><u>Converting units</u> – Children will convert metric measures and apply these to problems, while also looking at miles and kilometres and imperial measures.</p>
English	<p><u>Diary and award speeches</u> - Children will explore the details and aspects of writing diaries and speeches, and will be able to write effectively in the relevant styles.</p>
Science	<p><u>Animals including humans</u> - Children will explore the importance of good nutrition and how bones and muscles support and strengthen our bodies, as well as how blood works, the circulatory system, water and nutrients and blood disorders.</p>
History	<p><u>The Maya</u> – Discovering who the Mayan people were and investigating their lifestyle and impact on modern society.</p>
RE	<p><u>Loving, Vocation and commitment</u>– Children will explore the various acts of showing love and commitment, alongside what the definition of vocation is and exploring this in depth.</p>

Collective Worship	<u>Respect</u> – Children will explore the various Christian values and how we can live this out in our every day life.
Art	<u>Make my voice heard</u> – From the Ancient Maya to modern-day street art, children look at how artists convey a message. Exploring imagery, symbols, expressive mark making, and ‘chiaroscuro’ children consider audience and impact to create powerful drawings to make their voices heard.
Computing	<u>Coding</u> – Children will develop programming skills including design, coding, testing and debugging. They will develop their own playable game.
PE	<u>Power</u> - Developing physical skills in running, jumping and agile movement.
PSHE	<u>Being Me in My World</u> – Children will explore how to be part of a responsible and respected community. They will consider their rights, and explore democracy.
