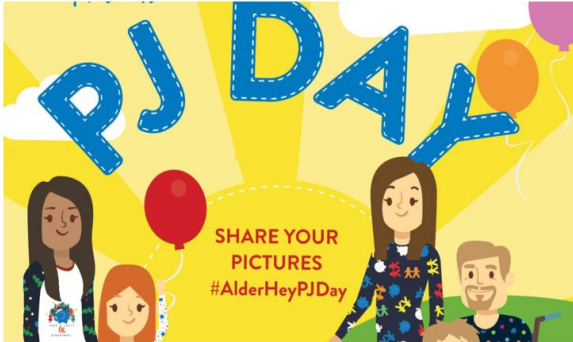

We would like to thank all our families for their efforts with attendance since the beginning of term. For all our children to do their best we need to keep up their efforts for the whole school year. Unfortunately, attendance has drastically dipped this week. Please see your child's class attendance for this week.

Reception	98%	Great
Year 1	96%	Good
Year 2	96%	Good
Year 4	89%	Very poor
Year 5	91%	Hard to achieve goals
Year 6	94%	Difficult to achieve your best

This is based on class attendance and not individual attendance. High levels of attendance at school significantly impact upon developmental outcomes. At Faith, we want the very best for every single pupil and we aim for 100% attendance wherever possible.

We understand that during winter there are rare coughs and colds but we remind parents that medication can be administered at school and children can recover from minor illnesses quickly. If in doubt consult school and if children are very ill we will always contact you and send them home. Good Attendance is important because there is a direct link between underachievement and attendance below 95%.

100% = 'outstanding'

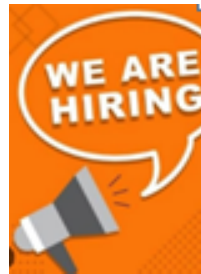
97% and above = 'great'

92% - 94% = '3 weeks off in a school year and it may be difficult to do your very best.'

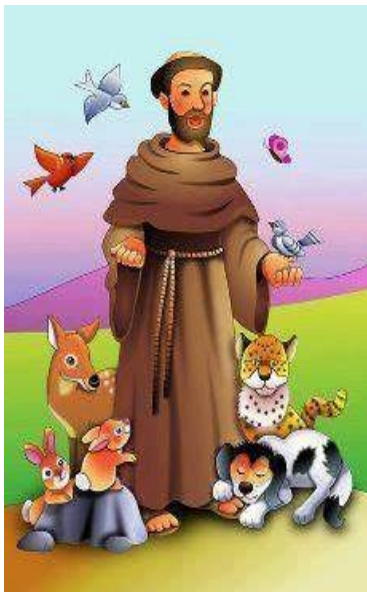
90% - 91% = '19 days off in a school year and will make it very hard to achieve your goals.'

90% and below = 'very poor attendance and I will be involved and it is very unlikely you will achieve good exam results.'
