Homework will be set each <u>Friday on Seesaw</u> and should be **completed by the following Thursday.** Reading books will be <u>sent home each Friday</u> and should be **returned by the following Thursday.**

This term we are going to be covering the following topic:				
The children will be revisiting counting knowledge that they have acquired during				
the previous half term and using this knowledge to remember their 'stopping				
number' when counting. Children will be beginning to look at addition and				
subtraction within 5, also exploring one more and one less of a given number. For				
shape, children will be looking at shapes with 4 sides and identifying these shapes				
in the environment around them.				
Star in a Jar: Reception will looking at posters, thinking about what a poster needs				
and why it is important. Our writing outcome this half term will be to write				
sentences that provides information about our missing star and create a poster.				
The children will be building on their knowledge of Set 1 sounds. All children will				
be practicing how to blend sounds into words orally and others will be beginning				
to read CVC words. All children are practicing their letter formation and some				
children will be beginning to write simple sentences including CVC words.				
<u>Celebrate Difference:</u> Reception will be learning about different celebrations				
around the world including Diwali, Bonfire Night and Remembrance Day.				
Reception will be introduced to special places that people pray. In link with				
science, children will be learning about shadows and changing states, including				
freezing, melting and cooking.				
Prophecy and Promise: pupils will be learning about the Nativity story this half				
term, learning about the key figures within the story. The children will be able to				
recall these key people and some will be able to retell the story of Jesus' birth.				

Collective Worship	Compassion: Reception will be introduced to the word compassion and think of how you can show compassion to others. They will listen to different scriptures and engage in different activities to help them understand further.
Art	Making Soup (Design Technology): The children will be learning about different fruits and vegetables. They will be working towards making a soup and go through the process of designing, practicing chopping and then working together as a class to make their own soup.
PSHE	<u>Celebrating Difference:</u> Reception will be thinking about what makes them different and unique. They will think about their looks, their families and their interests, they will then compare these with their friends and discuss why it is good to be different and celebrate this.
