This term we are going to be covering the following topic:	
Maths	<u>Addition and subtraction</u> - Children will be adding and subtracting 2-digit numbers. This will be through concrete resources, pictorial representations and abstract methods (column)
Phonics	Children will continue in their Read Write Inc. phonics groups, learning sounds, practising spelling and reading story books.
English	<u>Setting narrative</u> - Children will explore their new class text, The Night Gardener. Children will begin to use question marks, full stops and exclamation marks, they will be looking at apostrophes for possession and expanded noun phrases. <u>Diary</u> - Children will be looking at the structure of a diary.
Science	<u>Materials Monster</u> - Children will explore different materials and their properties, looking at suitability through experiments.
History	<u>Bonfire Night and the Great Fire of London</u> – Children will be learning about the two events and the significance of them today.
RE	<u>Prophecy and Promise</u> – Children will explore the story of Christmas.
Collective Worship	<u>Compassion</u> – Children will explore stories of compassion and how we can live this way.
DT	<u>Baby Bear's Chair</u> : Children will be exploring different structures and how we can make them stable before creating a chair for baby bear.
Computing	<u>Unplugged Algorithms</u> – Children will understand that an algorithm is a set of instructions.

PE	<u>Gymnastics</u> – Children will develop their gymnastic skills by learning new movements.
PSHE	<u>Celebrating difference</u> – Children will talk about all their similarities and differences as well as talking about ways to create a safe and fair class by standing up to bullying.
Music	Children will be learning new songs and looking at finding the pulse and rhythm in music.
