This term we are going to be covering the following topics:

Maths	<p><u>Addition and subtraction</u> - Children will begin to explore adding and subtracting 3-digit numbers.</p> <p><u>Statistics</u> - Children will learn how to interpret and draw pictograms and bar charts. They will collect their own data to create different types of graphs.</p> <p><u>Shape</u> - Children will learn the names of different 2-D and 3-D shapes. They will learn the names of different angles.</p>
English	<p><u>Fable Narrative and Information text</u> - Children will explore the book 'Fox'. They will use this text to complete two different writing outcomes - Fable Narrative and Information text.</p>
Science	<p><u>Rocks</u> - Children will learn about the three main types of rocks (Igneous, Sedimentary and Metamorphic). They will investigate how porous rocks are, how fossils are made and the layers of soil.</p>
History	<p><u>Cradles of Civilisation</u> - Children will learn about ancient civilisations such as Ancient Sumer. They will learn about how different civilisations were similar.</p>
RE	<p><u>Prophecy and Promise</u> - Children will learn about what happens at Mass and make links with scripture.</p>
Collective Worship	<p><u>Compassion</u> - Children will learn ways to show compassion.</p>
DT	<p><u>Cooking Seasonally</u> - Children will learn about where different foods are grown and how they are grown. They will have the opportunity to make stew and will design their own packaging.</p>
Computing	<p><u>Emails</u> - Children will learn what an e-mail is, how to send emails and how to attach pictures to an email using laptops.</p>
PE	<p><u>Hockey</u> - Children will learn the skills needed to play hockey.</p>
PSHE	<p><u>Celebrating Differences</u> - Children will learn that everyone is unique and they will gain an understanding of how to manage conflicts.</p>
