Homework and spellings will be set each <u>Friday</u> and should be completed by the following <u>Thursday</u>. Children should practice their reading by logging into Oxford Owl and engaging with their home reader which will be changed on a <u>Friday</u>. Home Readers should be in school EVERYDAY.

This term we are going to be covering the following topic:				
Maths	<u>Place value</u> - Children will explore place value up to 10 with concrete and pictorial apparatus and develop their reasoning skills through problem solving activities.			
English	<u>Finding Narrative & Writing Messages</u> - Children will explore these two writing outcomes through the novel 'Old Bear'. Children will build longer sentences by joining words with clauses and starting to join sentences to build narrative.			
Phonics	Read Write Inc-Children will explore Set 2 sounds reading and writing longer words that contain diagraphs such as 'toy', 'steel' and 'sail'.			
Science	Who Am I? - Children will explore the main bones and limbs of their bodies and the 5 senses and how they use their senses. Children will identify which body part belongs to each sense.			
History	History will be covered in Autumn 2			
RE	God, David and the Psalms – Children will explore the stories of David and his strengths and qualities.			
Collective Worship	Generosity – Children will explore the value of Generosity and how we can embody this in our lives in schools and the wider community.			
Design and Technology	<u>Making Smoothies</u> – Children will explore the differences between fruits and vegetables and conduct taste tasting to choose fruit to create their own smoothies. Children will work with 'Food for Thought' to produce their own recipes.			
Computing	<u>Basic Skills</u> – Children will explore basic computer skills such as logging onto to devices using a user name and password and completing an age related program independently.			
PE	<u>Movement</u> - Developing physical skills in running, jumping, negotiating spaces and moving in creative ways.			
PSHE	Being Me in My World – Children will explore similarities and difference they can see between themselves and others. Children will explore how these difference make each one of us unique and special.
