This term we are going to be covering the following topic:		
Maths	Fractions - Children will explore addition, subtraction, multiplication and division of	
	fractions. They will learn how to simplify fractions and convert before solving problems.	
English	Flashback narrative and persuasive letter - Children will explore our text, 'A story like the	
	wind' and the language structure and features, then will plan, write and edit their written	
	pieces.	
Science	Light - Children will explore how we see light, shadows, reflection and refraction. They will	
	learn how light travels and how this enables us to see.	
History	Ethiopia and Benin - Children will explore the rise and fall of power, kingdoms and	
	empires; they will also investigate how people gained power during this medieval time.	
Geography	Ethiopia – Children will explore the diversity of biomes, living conditions and the	
	difficulties faced for people across regions of Ethiopia.	
RE	Expectations – Children will develop an understanding of how their own and others'	
	decisions concerning expectations are informed by beliefs and values.	
Collective Worship	Compassion – Children will explore the value of compassion and how we can practice this	
-	value in our lives.	
Art	Playgrounds – Children will work on design and construct of playground equipment, using	
	aerial plans, design criteria and customer specifications.	
Computing	Spreadsheets – Children will develop understanding of spreadsheets and how they can be	
	used. They will develop skills in formatting and entering specific formulas.	
PE	Swimming - Developing swimming techniques and confidence in the water.	
PSHE	Celebrating Difference - We will look at different perceptions of what normal means and
